Reporting to the Head of Maintenance (AOC) and working closely with Operations Engineering Manager, the Reliability Monitoring Engineer is responsible for the upkeep of the fleet reliability program with the view of optimizing airline safety, reliability and economics of aircraft and their components

Key Accountabilities/Responsibilities

- Establish the Reliability Program manual and ensure it is current to meet Regulatory and ALS Requirements.
- Perform statistical analysis of aircraft system failures, components, power plants and structures to improve management of airworthiness and maintenance cost
- Establish the weekly repetitive defects and ECTM alerts
- Prepare monthly reliability reports, distribute same and schedule for the monthly reliability review meetings
- Initiate preliminary investigations and formulate recommendations for corrective and preventive actions for conditions that are above alert.
